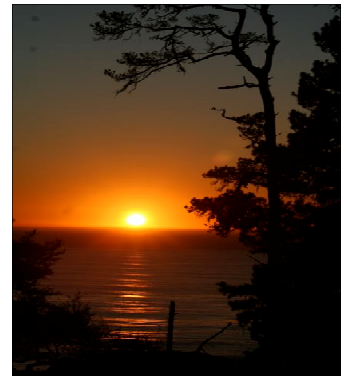


# CAMP OCEAN PINES SUMMER STRING WORKSHOP AUGUST 17-21, 2009

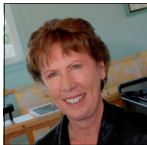
